ENTRY FEE PER TEAM (2 people per team) \$ 20.00 CASH. Kids 15 and under will need to register for prizes for 1st through 3rd place. Only legal fish caught by kids 15 and under can be weighed for prizes.

- · 1st place payout 70%
- · 2nd place payout 20%
- · 3rd place payout 10%

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Tournament Team is only allowed a maximum number of 2 people. You can have more than one team per boat.
- 2. Team may only fish from a boat in the boundaries of Lake Livingston, no fishing below the dam. You can fish from Coldspring Terrace fishing pier or a pier in the Terrace.
- 3. Team registration: contact Lewis Fowler / Renny Hardwick or day of tournament, contact info below.
- 4. Launch/leave from Coldspring Terrace boat ramp/fishing pier
- 5. Fishing time 7:00 AM until noon, weigh in starts at or before noon, must be at Coldspring Terrace boat ramp/fishing pier by noon to have fish weighed.
- 6. Each team may weigh a maximum of five (5) white bass.
- 7. Any white bass less than 10" will not be weighed. Any white bass brought to the weigh-in under size will disqualify the team.
- 8. This is a white bass tournament, no stripers or hybrid white bass will be weighed in.
- 9. All winners will be determined by weight. In the case of a tie the winner will be decided by a coin toss.
- 10. Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in total weight.
- 11. Big Bass pot is optional, entry fee for big bass is \$20.00 CASH per person. Payout for big bass is 100% of all money in pot. One white bass per team will be weighed for the teams who enter the big bass pot. If there is a tie for big fish, the pot will be split between the winners.
- 12. Fishing method is rod and reel.
- 13. All teams must follow local, state and federal regulations for fishing. Any team that violates any rules and regulations will be disqualified. Kids 15 and under do not need a fishing license.
- 14. Decisions of the judges are final.
- 15. White bass may be iced prior to weigh in, judges will determine the freshness of the fish.
- 16. Live wells and ice chests may/will be checked before the tournament begins.
- 17. Coldspring Terrace, the judges or personnel working the tournament are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
- 18. No professional guides are allowed if guides are found fishing on your team your team will be disqualified.
